- Colleagues from Latvia were responsible for organizing and moderating the 2nd day of ME.

Right after event a short questionnaire has been sent to the project partners in order to make a review of partners' satisfaction with the event.


There have been received 10 answers. All 7 partners provided their feedback. Lithuania, Iceland and Latvia submitted two answers.

The questions and the level of satisfaction might be seen in the diagrams below:


The content of the conference was informative

10 atsakymų




To what extent did the conference meet your expectations?



There have also been 2 open questions in order to allow participants to express the positive and areas of improvement related to the first ME.

The questionnaire asked:

- “What did you enjoy in this conference?”

The answers stated:

Sharing, motivation, knowledge.
The variety of people that spoke, the content of the thematics, the tools for participant's feedback.
The conference speakers covered so many areas: the project and its output itself, teaching on-line, motivation for students and teachers, for the staff in travel and hospitality, profiles of generations and their attitude to work and career.

- “What are the areas of improvement?”

The answers stated:

Innovation in learning.
Technical issue. And also for me conclusion is that better if the conference is provided by one organizer, or if there is two than its 2 different conferences. Cooperation was not successful, but I am glad that we make it happen. It was amazing, that if we exclude the partner organizational leaders, that from first day to second almost no body come.
